Many thanks for your generous support of Assistance League® of Los Angeles! We hope you enjoy this 2023 Impact Report that highlights how tens of thousands of vulnerable children and young adults were helped by the League in fiscal year 2023.

As always, the year was filled with many challenges and dynamic growth. Our membership grew by nearly 20%, especially within our Young Professionals Group and our College Alumni Auxiliary. League members and staff united to produce the first fundraising gala since the centennial, a fabulous Prom Day

experience for unhoused teens, three vibrant Family Days of Service, and a new member welcome tour, in addition to the ongoing work of our five service programs.

As homelessness, poverty, and food insecurity continue to escalate in L.A., League programs are a beacon of hope for youth in crisis. We are now reaching beyond L.A. Unified School District to offer programming to Inglewood and Compton school districts, as well. Thanks to foundation funding, we have also significantly increased the number of homeless youths served by our college scholarship program. When the needs of our community shift, the programming at the League strives to respond.

Our Programs

Utilizing online and in-person program delivery, our members collectively devoted 35,010 hours to guarantee an unforgettable League experience for 21,738 children and young adults. League programs are provided free of charge and with a lot of heart!

College Scholarship provided college funding to 56 students experiencing homelessness or in the foster care system. Awardees are supported at the same financial level throughout their college career.

Foster Children's Resource Center welcomed 1,782 foster youth to the Northridge center, for "free shopping" to select clothing, school supplies, grooming kits, backpacks, books, jackets, and toys.

Operation School Bell helped 8,499TK-6th graders with new clothing, backpacks, school supplies, grooming products, undergarments, shoes, socks, blankets, books, and toys.

Preschool Learning Center, accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children, provided an excellent preschool education to 49 students.

Theatre for Children Program held in-person performances, bringing the joy of musical theater to 11,000 children.

Court Referred Volunteer Center program, the League's service enterprise, enrolled 7,774 Angelenos who provided 545,765 volunteer service hours to local organizations throughout greater Los Angeles.


